Mitch Holthus

Mitch Holthus is the voice of the Kansas City Chiefs and is the longest tenured and most decorated play-by-play "voice" in franchise history. Holthus is also the host of the Hy-Vee Chiefs Insider television show and the Chiefs Rewind post game show featured on several digital platforms. Holthus is a member of the Kansas Association of Broadcasters Hall of Fame, The Kansas State University Athletics Hall of Fame and in June 2022 will be inducted into the Missouri Broadcasters Association Hall of Fame. Holthus has won four Emmys for his video and on-line work by the Academy of Television Arts and Sciences.

Power From Unexpected Sources
