RE COVID-19 Weekly Update

Since the last update, Monday, March 23, 2020-

- The Continuity Management Program (CMP) Team continues to meet daily to stay abreast of the ever changing situation.

- Shelter-at-home orders are effective in KS, MO, and this weekend, in MT. Millennium Corporate has been identified as an essential business. Effective Monday, March 30, a remote/in-office employee social distancing schedule will be implemented at all offices.
- Liquidity remains strong and substantial lines of credit are available to us, should we need them.
- NACHA COVID-19 guidelines were shared with coreCONNECT-ACH program users.
- Credit unions were contacted March 26th to provide contingency numbers for remote workers to aid in the verification of coreCONNECT transactions.
