Ops Update

Foreign Cash Letter & Collection Items Request Forms

The Foreign Cash Letter Items Request Form and the Foreign Collection Items Request Form have been updated to reflect new processing requirements and conditions regarding online gambling and marijuana industry payments. The new restriction added to the Criteria/Notes sections of the foreign collection and cash letter processing guidelines is as follows:

ITEMS PRESENTED WHERE THE FUNDS OR THE REMITTER DEAL WITH ONLINE GAMBLING, MARIJUANA, OR MARIJUANA PARAPHERNALIA, WILL NOT BE PROCESSED BY OUR VENDOR.
