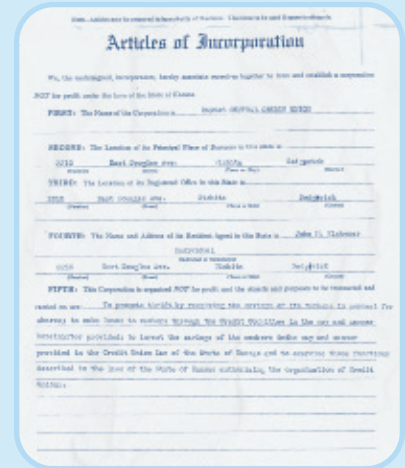
Celebrating Millennium Corporate's Anniversary

To access the updated URL, simply visit our website, and select **Login > coreCONNECT Login** in the upper right hand corner. Accessing coreCONNECT from our website ensures you are using the most secure and up-to-date link. If you have the old coreCONNECT URL bookmarked, you'll want to delete it and save the sparkly new link. And remember – only the URL is changing; your login credentials remain exactly as they are. So, once you visit our website, you'll be using the updated URL **in the "LINK" of an eye!**

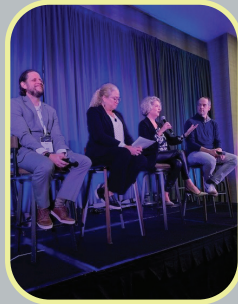
