

COMMANDER MARK NUTSCH

12 STRONG: An Extraordinary Mission of Commitment, Purpose, Heroism and Hope

As portrayed by actor Chris Hemsworth in the major motion picture, "12 Strong," Mark Nutsch (aka Mitch Nelson in the film) shares lessons learned in the now-declassified saga of a U.S. Special Forces team that overcame seemingly insurmountable odds to help achieve a historic military victory. Mark Nutsch shares the true-life story of helping lead what is considered the most successful unconventional warfare campaign in modern history, a victory that changed the course of our country and the world. In October 2001 following the attacks on 9/11, Nutsch led a heroic 12-man team of U.S. Special Forces on a covert mission to Afghanistan, where they would ride to war on horses to fight the enemy—side by side with their Muslim counterparts—capture the strategic city of Mazar-i-Sharif within a matter of weeks, and successfully overthrow the Taliban. Now a consultant to Special Operations Command, he earned a Bronze Star with valor for his bravery. Nutsch reveals leadership and teamwork lessons from the military victory that can be applied to any organizational culture.

JOHN B NORRIS, V

US Economy in 2018: Just What in the Heck is Happening?

Mr. Norris is the Managing Director and Head of Wealth Management for Oakworth Capital Bank. Prior to help starting Oakworth, Mr. Norris was chief economist, chairman of the investment strategy committee, and a senior fund manager for Regions Financial Corporation's Morgan Asset Management (MAM) subsidiary. Before joining Regions he served as the chief investment officer for The Trust Company of Sterne, Agee & Leach, Inc. and started his professional career with Mercantile-Safe Deposit & Trust Company in Baltimore, Maryland, as an institutional fixed income portfolio manager. Mr. Norris has been guest columnist to the Montgomery Advertiser's business section for over a decade. Currently, he serves on the Board of Dir. for The Literacy Council of Central AL, and on the advisory board for the economics/finance department at Samford's Brock School of Business. Our speaker, John Norris, will dissect the US economy and discuss the current strength of economic activity and its broad component parts: the consumer, business investment, and government spending. John will tell us some of the things his firm analyzes which could alter GDP forecasts over the next 12 months, leading into a short discussion on the financial markets, and what all this economic talk means for investors.

Alix Patterson is a partner at Callahan & Associates and oversees the firm's Client Success Unit as well as serves on Callahan's Board of Directors. She is a lifelong credit union member and has more than 17 years of credit union industry experience. Alix has a keen ability to "see the story" within the data and has a firm grasp on the numbers credit unions need to make important decisions. She is talented at pinpointing strategic patterns and applying her data-grounded insights at both micro and macro levels to guide credit unions' success. Prior to joining Callahan, Alix worked in the Washington, DC, research office of the Tokyo Electric Power Company and spent a year coaching the University of Michigan women's rowing team. She holds a bachelor's degree in Japanese and political science from the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor, a master's degree in international affairs from the School of Advanced International Studies at Johns Hopkins University in Washington, DC, and an MBA with distinction from the University of Oxford SAID Business School in England. In 2017, credit unions once again posted record highs in membership, loans, and shares, all while keeping earnings and delinquency stable. That's all well and good, but it's also a recipe for complacency. Now is the time to step up and ask tough questions of your executives, your board, and your regulator. Join Alix Patterson as she reviews industry highlights and challenges you to ask how your credit union can be even better.
